

Benefits

- A ratio of one carer to each child
- A personalised approach based on each childs needs.
- Activities that are designed to stimulate your childs development
- Socialisation with other children and carers that is not available with in-home care.
- Supoport to parents and guardians to enhance the whole family's quality of life.
- Coffee mornings to provide an opportunity to share with other families
- Weekly music program.

Costs

We understand that additional needs come with additional costs in many ways and we want to alleviate that burden as much as we can.

We are a not-for-profit initiative through the Ringwood Uniting Church and as such only ask for a contribution of \$10 per child per day.
